



YUKON SERVICE PIN CRITERIA AND APPLICATION

This pin is to recognize the people in and/or from Yukon who have served or are serving in the military or as a first responder.

A first responder includes:

- paramedics;
- emergency medical technicians;
- police officers (RCMP or other);
- firefighters;
- rescuers; and
- other trained members of organizations connected to this type of work, either as a volunteer or as a paid employee.

Military includes all branches of the Canadian military, including the Canadian Rangers. You can only receive the pin one time.

Criteria for the Yukon Service Pin

To receive a pin you must:

- be a Canadian citizen who has served or is serving in the military or as a first responder and was/is based in Yukon; or
- be born in Yukon and has served or is serving in the military or as a first responder inside or outside of Yukon.
